The University of Bridgeport Physician Assistant Institute is authorized to award AAPA sponsored Category I CME to our PA preceptors. Please accept this as a token of our appreciation of your efforts in educating, guiding, and preparing our students for clinical practice.

AAPA CME STATEMENT: University of Bridgeport has been authorized by the American Academy of PAs (AAPA) to award AAPA Category 1 CME credit to eligible PA preceptors. Approval is valid from 2/1/2025 to 2/1/2027. AAPA reference number: CME-208810.

Each PA preceptor is eligible to earn 2 hours of Category 1 CME for every 40 hours spent precepting a student. The AAPA has removed the maximum allowable number of hours that can be claimed (previously there was a limit of 20 credits per year). At this time, Category I CME certificates may be awarded only to PA preceptors, as supported by the AAPA.

Attached please find the Preceptor Evaluation and Reporting form. Please complete all sections and return to the University of Bridgeport Physician Assistant Institute no later than 12/31 for the calendar year you wish to to receive CME credit for hours precepted. Preceptors are responsible for tracking hours and should only claim hours spent directly precepting students.
