Executive Summary

This report presents the CAT assessment (ETS #6412) results for the University of Bridgeport School of Education for the 2024-2025 academic year. The analysis includes 29 test records from 29 unique candidates enrolled in the Sixth Year/092 Certification Program in Educational Leadership.

Analysis by Repeat Test Takers: 2024-2025

Across the three year period from September 2022 to August 2025, only two candidates did not pass the exam on first attempt, and both candidates did not re-attempt the CAT exam. The candidate who did not pass the CAT exam on first attempt in 2024-2025 did not retake the exam within the 2024-2025 academic year. The candidate's score was less than 10 points below state proficiency score. We will reach out to these candidates to provide support and monitor future retake attempts.

Summary and Recommendations

The 2024-2025 CAT exam data demonstrate strong overall performance at the University of Bridgeport School of Education.

Key observations include:

Strengths:

- Overall pass rate of 96.55% demonstrates overall program effectiveness
- Disaggregated CAT Exam results demonstrate high levels of performance across gender and most race/ethnicity groups. Candidates identifying as White, Black or African American, Hispanic or Latino, and Asian or Asian American achieved **100% pass rates**.

Areas for Attention:

- One subgroup, Puerto Rican candidates, demonstrated a lower pass rate (66.67%) based on a small sample size (n=3). We will continue monitor disaggregated data as part of the program's commitment to equitable outcomes and continuous improvement and consider enhanced test preparation resources for this demographic group as needed.
