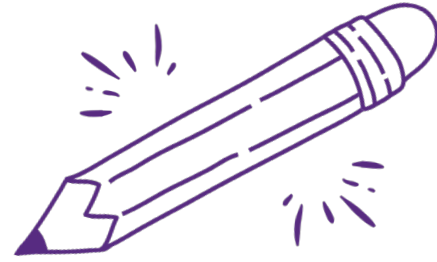


Choosing the right college to apply to may feel overwhelming – that’s why we make the application process as smooth as it can be!

How to apply to UB

- ☐ Complete your free UB application at bridgeport.edu/apply.
- ☐ Submit **proof of high school completion or its equivalent** (*this would typically be a transcript provided by your school’s advising office*).

For first-year applicants:

- ☐ Submit a **personal essay**.
UB is test optional! You are not required to submit your SAT/ACT scores.

For transfer applicants:

- ☐ Submit transcripts from all colleges/universities attended.

Submit your FAFSA

- ☐ Confirm UB has your **social security number** by contacting Admissions at 203-576-4552.
 - This is how we connect your FAFSA with your UB application.
- ☐ Create an FSA ID at studentaid.gov.
 - Write down your username and password so you can access and submit the 2024–2025 FAFSA form when it is available.
- ☐ Once available, complete the FAFSA at studentaid.gov and use **UB’s school code 001416**.

UB considers all applicants for available merit scholarships, including:

- Trustee Scholarship: **\$23,000–\$25,000**
- Presidential Scholarship: **\$20,000**
- Provost’s Scholarship: **\$17,000–\$17,500**
- Dean’s Achievement Scholarship: **\$15,000**

You could be eligible for a \$1,500/semester scholarship!
