How to apply to UB

Complete your free UB application
at bridgeport.edu/apply .

Submit proof of high school completion or its equivalent (this would typically be a transcript provided by your school's advising office).

For first-year applicants:

Submit a **personal essay**.*

UB is test optional! You are not required to submit your SAT/ACT scores.

For transfer applicants:

Submit transcripts from all colleges/universities attended.

Submit your FAFSA

Confirm UB has your social security

- This is how we connect your FAFSA with your UB application.
- Create an FSA ID at **studentaid.gov**.
 - Write down your username and password so you can access and submit the 2024–2025 FAFSA form when it is available.
- Once available, complete the FAFSA at studentaid.gov and use UB's school code 001416.

UB considers all applicants for available merit scholarships, including:

- Trustee Scholarship: **\$23,000-\$25,000**
- Presidential Scholarship: \$20,000
- Provost's Scholarship: \$17,000-\$17,500
- Dean's Achievement Scholarship: \$15,000
