
Overview






Diversity at a Glance: Race

Respondents by Race/Ethnicity





Diversity at a Glance: Gender




Diversity at a Glance: Sexual Orientation

Respondents by Sexual Orientation












During your time at this institution, about how often have you heard someone make an insensitive or disparaging remark about: % Sometimes, Often, or Very often

Source of Insensitive/Disparaging Remarks (% of Respondents Who Selected Each Source)





Harassment and Discrimination


In the survey, respondents saw the following definitions of discrimination and harassment:

- **Discrimination** is the unfavorable treatment of a person based on that person's race, ethnicity, national origin, socioeconomic status, age, perceived or actual physical or mental disability, pregnancy, sex, sexual orientation, gender identity, marital status, creed, religion, or political beliefs.
- Harassment is a form of discrimination consisting of physical or verbal conduct that denigrates or shows hostility toward an individual because of their race, ethnicity, national origin, socioeconomic status, age, perceived or actual physical or mental disability, pregnancy, sex, sexual orientation, gender identity, marital status, creed, religion, or political beliefs. Harassment occurs when the conduct is sufficiently severe and/or pervasive that it alters the terms or conditions of employment or substantially limits the ability of a student to participate in or benefit from the college's educational and/or social programs.


Have you ever been discriminated against or harassed on this campus, at an off-campus residence, or at an off-campus program/event affiliated with this institution?



Did any of these incidents of discrimination or harassment at this institution occur in the last year?




Source of Discrimination/Harassment (% of Respondents Who Selected Each Source)


















The campus experience/environment regarding diversity at University of Bridgeport: *Graduate Students*











The extent to which you experience a sense of belonging or community at University of Bridgeport: *Undergraduate Students*














To what extent do you agree that diversity on campus improves experiences and interactions within the classroom, the workplace, and the overall community?










Overall, how comfortable would you be sharing your views on diversity and equity at University of Bridgeport? *Undergraduate Students*




Overall, how comfortable would you be sharing your views on diversity and equity at University of Bridgeport? *Graduate Students*
