
### Admission requirements

- Submit transcripts:
  - Proof of high school completion or its equivalent
  - Transcripts from all colleges/universities attended (transfer applicants)
- Students must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5
- First-year students must submit a personal essay (optional if you choose to submit SAT/ACT scores)
