Attending events like Open House, Accepted Students Day, and our weekly campus tours can be great ways to meet future Purple Knights.

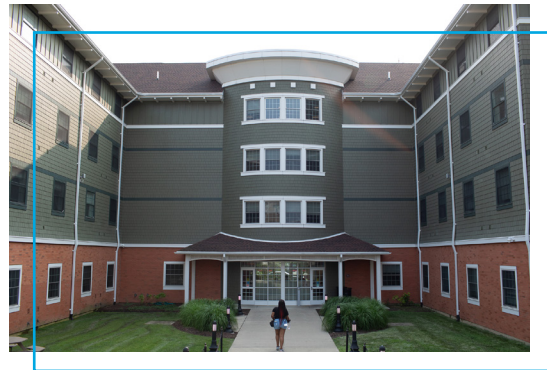
