Bachelor of Science in Psychology online

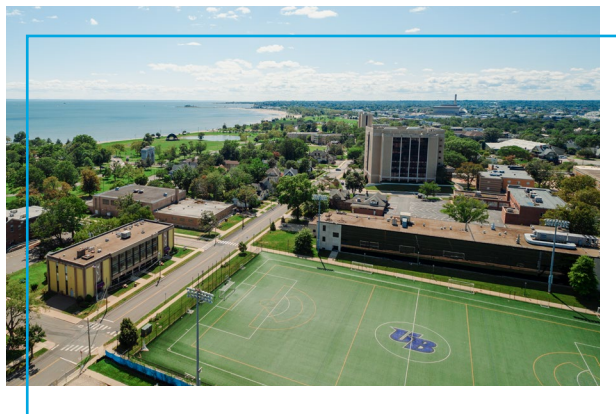
In this program, we'll prepare you with the skills and experience needed for a rewarding career in the field of psychology in a flexible, fully online format.

Concentration: Substance Use Counselor in Training

Psychology students who aspire to work with individuals in substance use treatment programs have the unique opportunity to prepare for their Certified Addiction Counselor (CAC) certificate exam. Our Substance Use Counselor in Training concentration combines specialized coursework with hands-on learning — equipping you with the knowledge, skills, and confidence needed to pursue your CAC certificate after graduation.



Admission requirements

- Complete the application for enrollment at bridgeport.edu/apply
- Submit transcripts
 - Submit proof of high school completion or its equivalent
 - Submit transcripts from all colleges/universities attended (*transfer applicants*)
- Students must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5
- First-year students must submit a personal essay (optional if you choose to submit SAT/ACT scores)
