TITLE:	Admission of Sex Offenders

POLICY STATEMENT:

The University of Bridgeport does not accept applicants that are convicted felons on the CT State Registry for Sex Offenders due to the close proximity of schools located on campus.

PROCEDURE DETAILS:

All applicants are required to indicate if they have a criminal conviction on the University of Bridgeport application for admission. If an applicant indicates "Yes" to having a felony conviction, students are asked to explain the incident, state the charges they were convicted of, and include documentation of the nature of the offense. Once these applicants complete their application and can be reviewed for Admission, the Admission Officer downloads their full application from Slate, including any requested documentation, and sends this to the Dean of Students. The Dean of Students reviews the student and consults a database that includes the charges and decides if the student is eligible for admission based on those charges. If the Dean of Students determines the student is not eligible for admission, the Admissions Officer rejects the student and adds a note in their Slate application. If the Dean of Students determines the student is eligible for admission, the Admission Officer adds a notes in their Slate application and determines if the student meets criteria for admission to UB.
