

COVID-19 GUIDELINES

Residential Life



COMMUNITY KITCHENS WILL BE CLOSED

- Residents should rely on microwave cook options
- ResLife staff will work to provide resources about microwave cooking

LIMIT TRAFFIC IN THE LAUNDRY ROOM

- Masks must be worn in the laundry room
- Keep tabs on your laundry online at www.laundryview.com/Bridgeport
- Download the CSC ServiceWorks app to report issues with the washer & dryers

NO OUTSIDE GUEST

- No guest including UB commuters will be allowed to visit the residential halls
- Visitation hours are from 2 pm to 12 am
- No overnights are permitted including current residential students

BATHROOM EXPECTATIONS

- Masks are required when you use the bathrooms
- Limit the time in the bathroom to 45 -60 minutes
- No personal items like cellphones and speakers are allowed in the bathrooms

MASKS ARE REQUIRED OUTSIDE OF YOUR ROOM

LIMITED ROOM CHANGES

- All roommates are required to fill out the roommate agreement prior to starting the semester
- Room changes will only occur on an emergency basis
- If a student wants to remain as a single occupant in their room they can purchase the room out for \$10,375

ALWAYS BE PREPARED

All students should have a carry-on or duffel bag prepared ahead of time with:

1. Comfortable outfits (weather friendly)
2. Undergarments for several days
3. Toiletries

Just in case there is a need for quarantine or isolation

TESTED POSITIVE OR EXPOSED TO SOMEONE WHO TESTED POSITIVE

If a residential student is confirmed positive for COVID-19 or has been in close contact with someone who has COVID-19 they will be:

1. Temporarily moved to a new housing Assignment to protect the community
2. Alternatively, students may return home to be cared for by family members

Students in quarantine or isolation must adhere to the assignment of sink, toilet & shower stall.

WEEKLY TESTING

- Residential students that are selected randomly for weekly testing are required to participate.
- Students in quarantine or isolation will be subjected to target testing during their time in either location.
